

NEW COACH MEETING

What to bring??

GAME DAY ROSTER



PLAYER/COACH PASSES



Should be cut out and folded in half for each player

Please be prepared as the home team to change your jersey in the event of a conflict.

REFEREE FEE



Build out line.

- Players on the team without the ball must retreat behind the buildout line. They must remain there until the goalkeeper releases the ball from her hands; or when the goal kick touches a second person or leaves the penalty area.
- Infractions of the goal kick will result in a rekick.
- Infractions of the release by the goalkeeper will result in an indirect free kick from the spot the keeper possessed the ball at the time the line was crossed. During the IDK the opposing team must again retreat behind the buildout line.
- Players can NOT be in an offside position until they cross their opponents buildout line.

Rescheduling & Club Passes

- Reschedule procedure on sjgsl.org
- Rescheduling done through Mike.
- CP players are designated players who are from other teams in your age or a younger team.
- They must be requested by your club.
- Players can be changed mid season but can require up to 96 hours to complete the switch. They are not eligible until they appear on the GDR.

COVID Protocol

- SJGSL follows NJDOH guidelines for sanctioned events.
- Clubs may have more strict requirements so please check with the home coach to ensure all procedures are met.
- SJGSL leaves it up clubs to decide if both teams will occupy the same side of the field, or opposite sides. If teams occupy separate sides, spectators must stay 5 yd from the bench area.
- COVID check-in: Coach will retain passes at all times and give GDR and Referee Fee to the official.
- Coach will read player name from the pass, present the pass for the referee to look at; the player will raise her hand to identify herself, and show her number.
- ▶ Teams will only send ONE (1) captain for the coin toss!

Score Reporting & Referee Evaluation!

- Score reporting MUST be done after every match by the home team. It will appear in your schedule once entered.
- The link and the phone number to call to report scores is at the top of the GDR, as well as the QR code which can be used.
- Referee evaluations can be found on sigsl.org in the left panel.
- The eval must be completed after each match by both teams.

Problems to this point?

- Are your passes, background check, safe sport, and sideline sports doc requirements met?
- Have you contacted your opponent to confirm match time and location, uniform color, COVID protocol, etc?
- Do all of your players have approved passes?
- Do you know where to print your GDR?
- If any are no, please contact your club rep for help.

Who do I contact if there is a problem?

- For MATCH DAY issues at the field, PLEASE CONTACT US.
- ▶ If a referee is more than 15 minutes late for kickoff.
- ▶ If there is an issue with check in relating to cards or GDR
- If an opponent has not arrived by match time.
